- A Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan (MJHMP) is a community-driven, living document that communities use to reduce their vulnerability to natural and human-made hazards.
- Counties and municipalities must adopt a FEMA-approved plan in order to be eligible for Hazard Mitigation Assistance (HMA) funds.
- In order to meet the minimum threshold, set by PEMA and FEMA, **all 48 municipalities within Huntingdon County must attend at least one meeting, complete at least one worksheet, and identify at least one mitigation action during the 2020 Huntingdon County MJHMP update process.**
