The regular meeting of the Huntingdon County Commissioners was held on the above date and time in the Commissioner's Meeting Room with the following present: Commissioners Sather and Walls; Solicitor, Larry Newton; Chief Clerk, Heather Fellman; Natasha Brubaker from the Center for Community Action; Daily News Reporter, Joe Thompson and guest Curtis McConaughy and Karen Rush.

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Commissioner Sather. Prayer was led by Commissioner Walls and the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was led by Commissioner Sather.

Consideration of approval was given to hire Tim Banks for the position of Custodian. The effective date of his hiring is 10/19/2023. It was moved by Commissioner Wall, seconded by Commissioner Sather and carried (Walls, yes; Sather, yes).
