

The regular weekly meeting of the Huntingdon County Commissioners was held on the above date and time in the Commissioners meeting room with the following being present: Commissioners O’Korn, Fluke and Thomas; Chief Clerk, Michelle Cerett; Probation Director, Len Hahn; Planning Director, Mark Colussy; Grant Administrator, Maureen Safko; CYS Supervisors, Sabrina Peters, Sarah Shaner, Nicole Leturgy; Daily news reporter, Claire Williams; WTAJ Reporter, Aaron Thomas; and visitors Mark Sather and Jim Cassatt.

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Commissioner O’Korn followed by prayer led by Commissioner Fluke and the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag led by Commissioner Thomas.

It was moved by Commissioner Fluke, seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (O’Korn, yes; Fluke, yes; Thomas, yes) to approve the minutes of the August 11th public meeting.

It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Fluke and carried (Fluke, yes; Thomas, yes; O’Korn, yes) to approve the payment of bills.

There was one resignation added to the agenda today.

There were no announcements, public comments or matters addressed by the Solicitor today.

Len Hahn, Probation Director presented a contract with Alcohol Monitoring Services for the use of monitoring bracelets. He stated that the company he is using now does not offer the alcohol monitoring and their services are more expensive than the new ones through AMS. It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Fluke and carried (Thomas, yes; O’Korn, yes; Fluke, yes) to approve the contract with Alcohol Monitoring Services for a contract period of two years.

Mark Colussy and Maureen Safko were present today with two requests. Mark requested permission to attend the American Planning Association Conference on October 18th, 19th and 20th. The cost of the conference is \$375.00 and he will share a room with another County Planner so the room costs will be approximately \$200.00. In addition, Mark requested permission for Maureen Safko to travel to one day of the conference to do a presentation. It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Fluke and carried (O’Korn, yes; Fluke, yes; Thomas, yes) to approve the training and travel expenses as requested.

Maureen requested approval to use CDBG funds to hire an architect to update the County Section 504 plan, which is a requirement for CDBG funds. The plan was prepared in 1991 but has never been completely updated. If approved, the architect will assess each County building for barriers to the physically handicapped. After discussion, it was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner O’Korn and carried (Fluke, no; Thomas, yes; O’Korn, yes) to approve the hiring of the architect as requested.

Michelle received a letter this morning from Adam Miller tendering his resignation. She requested it be added to today’s agenda so actions can be taken for a replacement. It was moved by Commissioner Fluke, seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (Thomas, yes; O’Korn, yes; Fluke, yes) to accept the resignation of Adam Miller, EMA Director effective September 4th, 2015.

Michelle requested a revision to resolution 14-2015 due to two typographical errors. After speaking with the Solicitor, she requested the revision be tabled until she can confirm if it needs re-advertised. It was moved by Commissioner Fluke, seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (O’Korn, yes; Fluke, yes; Thomas, yes) to table the revision of Resolution 14-2015.

There were no Veteran burial allowances for approval today.

There being no further business, it was moved by Commissioner Thomas to adjourn the meeting at 10:09 a.m. Minutes prepared by Michelle L. Cerett, Chief Clerk.
