The regular weekly meeting of the Huntingdon County Commissioners was held on the above date and time in the Commissioners meeting room with the following being present: Commissioners O’Korn, Fluke and Thomas; Solicitor, Peter McManamon; Chief Clerk, Michelle Cerett; Daily News Reporter, Candy Price and visitor Bruce Pergament.

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Commissioner O’Korn followed by prayer led by Commissioner Thomas and the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag led by Commissioner O’Korn.

It was moved by Commissioner Fluke, seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (O’Korn, yes; Fluke, yes; Thomas, yes) to approve the minutes of the February 11th public meeting.

The agency is currently serving 18 children under the Intellectual disabilities program, 88 individuals in consolidated services, 236 are receiving mental health services and 55 are receiving early intervention services. Chris also provided an update on the heating unit in the agency, which malfunctioned recently.
