

The regular weekly meeting of the Huntingdon County Commissioners was held on the above date and time in the Commissioners meeting room with the following being present: Commissioners Sather, Walls, and Thomas; Chief Clerk, Michelle Barnett; Solicitor, Peter McManamon; Probation Director, Len Hahn; Planning Director, Mark Colussy; Domestic Relations Director, Kathy Richards; Administrator, Juniata Valley Behavioral and Developmental Services, Chris Wysocki; Daily News Reporter, Kylie Hawn; and visitor Jim Cassatt,

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Commissioner Sather followed by prayer led by Commissioner Walls and the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag led by Commissioner Sather.

It was moved by Commissioner Walls, seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (Sather, yes; Walls, yes; Thomas, yes) to approve the minutes of the April 25th public meeting.

It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Walls and carried (Walls, yes; Thomas, yes; Sather, yes) to approve the payment of bills.

One Addition to the Agenda was a personnel issue.

Commissioner Thomas made an announcement to commend Zachary Irvin on receipt of the Eagle Scout Award.

There were no public comments.

There were no matters addressed by the Solicitor.

Mark Colussy, Planning Director requested approval to submit a letter requesting an extension to the Broad Top City Borough Home Program. It was moved by Commissioner Walls seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (Thomas, yes; Sather, yes; Walls, yes) to approve submittal of the request for extension through January 21, 2018.

Chris Wysocki, Administrator at Juniata Valley Behavioral and Developmental Services, presented a quarterly report. Mental Health zeroed out this fiscal year. Due to funding cuts, some services may be removed. Funding cuts are not being aimed at disability or early intervention areas.

Len Hahn, Probation Director, requested approval to submit the Adult Grant-in-Aid and Supervision Fund for Fiscal Years 2017-2022. It was moved by Commissioner Thomas seconded by Commissioner Walls and carried (Sather, yes; Walls yes; Thomas, yes) to approve submittal of the Grant-in-Aid and Supervision Fund effective July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2022.

Kathy Richards, Director of Domestic Relations, requested approval of the Laserfische Addendum. This addendum addresses additional labor costs for necessary work to validate the tool process into the project. Costs to be covered 100% by BCSE. It was moved by Commissioner Thomas seconded by Commissioner Walls and carried (Walls, yes; Thomas yes; Sather, yes) to approve the addendum to the Laserfische agreement.

There was a request to terminate the employment of Ruby Keller, Deputy Register of Wills/Recorder of Deeds and Orphans Court effective May 1, 2017. It was moved by Commissioner Thomas seconded by Commissioner Walls and carried (Thomas, yes; Sather yes; Walls, yes) .

There was 1 Veteran Burial Allowance for approval today.

There being no further business, it was moved by Commissioner Walls to adjourn the meeting at 10:13 a.m.
