

The regular weekly meeting of the Huntingdon County Commissioners was held on the above date and time in the Commissioners meeting room with the following being present: Commissioners O’Korn, Fluke and Thomas; Chief Clerk, Michelle Cerett; Solicitor, Pete McManamon; Daily News Reporter Zach Myers and visitors Barb Covert, Jarred Covert, Jim Cassatt and Bruce Pergament.

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Commissioner O’Korn followed by prayer led by Commissioner Fluke and the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag led by Commissioner Thomas.

It was moved by Commissioner Fluke, seconded by Commissioner O’Korn and carried (O’Korn, yes; Fluke, yes; Thomas, abstain) to approve of the minutes of the July 15th public meeting.

It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Fluke and carried (Fluke, yes; Thomas, yes; O’Korn, yes) to approve the payment of bills.

There were no additions to the agenda, items addressed by the Solicitor or public comments today.

Commissioner Thomas welcomed Jarred and Barbara Covert to the meeting. Jarred is working on his Citizenship in the Community badge for Boy Scouts and he belongs to Troop 237 from Orbisonia. Commissioner O’Korn announced there will be no public meeting on August 5th due to the Commissioners attending the CCAP conference.

First on the agenda today were two personnel matters for the Jail. It was moved by Commissioner Fluke, seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (Thomas, yes; O’Korn, yes; Fluke, yes) to accept the resignation of Curtis Behm from the County jail effective July 22nd, 2014.

It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Fluke and carried (O’Korn, yes; Fluke, yes; Thomas, yes) to approve the termination of David Ormsby, Corrections Officer effective July 14, 2014.

Detective Charles Streightiff requested adoption of a resolution to apply for the DUI Task Force grant. Due to a court matter, he was not available to attend the meeting. After discussion, it was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Fluke and carried (Fluke, yes; Thomas, yes; O’Korn, yes) to adopt resolution 12-2014, granting Detective Streightiff permission to apply for the grant as requested. Commissioner O’Korn noted that this grant is for \$10,000.00 and has been in place for several years.

There were two county veteran burial allowances, installation of one government headstone and installation of one private headstone for approval today.

There being no further business, it was moved by Commissioner Fluke to adjourn the meeting at 9:49 a.m.
