Heather Fellman, Chief Clerk, requested consideration of approval to hire Tammy Starr for the position of Custodial Supervisor effective 9/18/2023. It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Walls and carried (Thomas, yes; Sather, yes; Walls, yes).
