The regular weekly meeting of the Huntingdon County Commissioners was held on the above date and time in the Commissioners meeting room with the following being present: Commissioners Sather, Walls and Thomas; Chief Clerk, Michelle Barnett; Solicitor, Peter McManamon; Probation Director, Len Hahn; Bob Henry from JVBDS; Shelly Rivello, Huntingdon County Walk Chair; Daily News Reporter, Kylie Hawn and visitor, Jim Cassatt.

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Commissioner Sather followed by prayer led by Commissioner Thomas and the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag led by Commissioner Walls.

It was moved by Commissioner Walls, seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (Sather, yes; Walls, yes; Thomas, yes) to approve the minutes of the August 29th public meeting.

It was moved by Commissioner Thomas seconded by Commissioner Walls and carried (Walls, yes; Thomas, yes; Sather, yes) to approve the payment of bills.

There were no additions to the agenda, announcements, public comments or matters to be addressed by the Solicitor today.

First on the agenda today was opening of bids for fuel oil for the 2017/2018 heating season. The following two bids were received:

The bids will be reviewed and considered at next week's meeting.

Probation Director, Len Hahn, had a request to accept the resignation of Sierra Brumbaugh, Adult Probation Officer. It was moved by Commissioner Walls and seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (Thomas, yes; Sather, yes; Walls, yes) to accept the resignation of Sierra Brumbaugh effective August 24, 2017.

Bob Henry JVBDS and Shelly Rivello, Huntingdon County Walk Chair was present to request the approval of a Proclamation to proclaim the first Sunday of October as Suicide Awareness and Prevention Day. It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Walls and carried (Sather, yes; Walls, yes; Thomas, yes) to approve the Proclamation. The Joinder Proclamation was resolved by Huntingdon, Mifflin and Juniata Counties acting as Juniata Valley Behavior and Developmental Services. Shelly announced a Candlelight Vigil to be held September 10, 2017 at 7:15 p.m. on the Huntingdon County Courthouse steps.

Commissioner Sather provided discussion on the 2016 PA Department of Transportation Bridge Bundle Project. This project was funded by PA DOT with the County being responsible to pay \$35,687.00, which is 5% of the total repair costs. The total bid price was \$784,000. There were four structurally deficient bridges repaired which included, T-403 Aughwick Creek Bridge, T308 Aughwick Creek Bridge, T369 Great Trough Creek Bridge and T342 Three Springs Creek Bridge.

There were 3 Veteran Burial Allowance for approval today.

There being no further business, it was moved by Commissioner Walls to adjourn the meeting at 9:50 a.m.
