DRAFT PLAN AVAILABLE FOR REVIEW

A draft version of the updated Huntingdon County Hazard Mitigation Plan is now available for review.

The plan outlines the hazards that can affect Huntingdon County and its municipalities, and the actions that can be taken to reduce the impact of these hazards that may can occur in the various communities and the county.

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) requires state, county and local governments to develop and adopt hazard mitigation plans as a condition for receiving certain types of non-emergency disaster assistance, including funding for mitigation projects. Jurisdictions must update their hazard mitigation plans and re-submit them for FEMA approval every five years to maintain eligibility.
