There is a \$900 increase for this change order. It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Reeder and carried (Walls, yes; Thomas, yes; Reeder, yes).

Consideration of approval was given for Penn State Construction Change Order #2 for the Courthouse Renovation Project. This is to restore the Courtroom ceiling and finish the walls in the shower area that was removed from the contract under Change Order #1. There is no cost for this change order. It was moved by Commissioner Reeder, seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (Thomas, yes; Reeder, yes; Walls, yes).

Consideration of approval was given for Penn State Construction Change Order #3 for the Courthouse Renovation Project. This is to modify the ceiling finish in rooms 2 and 5 to comply with standard requirements. There is a total increase of \$6,988.69 for this change order. It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Reeder and carried (Reeder, yes; Walls, yes; Thomas, yes).

There were no Matters for Action.

There were no Veteran's Burial Allowance.

There being no further business, it was moved by Commissioner Reeder to adjourn the meeting at 9:43 a.m.
