


LOGAN TOWNSHIP Official General Election Ballot Huntingdon County, Pennsylvania November 6, 2018



MAPLETON BOROUGH Official General Election Ballot Huntingdon County, Pennsylvania November 6, 2018




MARKLESBURG BOROUGH Official General Election Ballot Huntingdon County, Pennsylvania November 6, 2018
