The regular weekly meeting of the Huntingdon County Commissioners was held on the above date and time in the Commissioners meeting room with the following being present: Commissioners O'Korn, Fluke and Thomas; Chief Clerk, Michelle Cerett; Solicitor, Peter McManamon; Daily News reporter, Jeff Gill; Altoona Mirror reporter, John Hoffstetler; and visitors Bruce Pergament, and Jim Cassatt.

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Commissioner O'Korn followed by Prayer led by Commissioner Fluke and the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag led by Commissioner Thomas.

There were no additions or corrections to the April 3rd minutes.

It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Fluke and carried (O'Korn, yes; Fluke, yes; Thomas, yes) to approve the minutes of the April 3rd meeting.

It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Fluke and carried (Thomas, yes; O'Korn, yes; Fluke, yes) to re-adopt Ordinance 01-2012 permitting the County to implement a Marcellus Shale impact fee.

Penn DOT provided an Engineering agreement for St. Mary's bridge for an amount not to exceed \$69,038.43. Solicitor McManamon has reviewed the agreement. It was moved by Commissionr Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Fluke and carried (O'Korn, yes; Fluke, yes; Thomas, yes) to approve the Engineering agreement as presented.

Brian Young, Mapping Director requested permission to attend the State GIS conference May 22^{nd} and 23^{rd} in Grantville, PA. The cost of the conference is \$199.00 and the room charge is \$96.46. It was moved by Commissioner Fluke, seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (Fluke, yes; Thomas, yes; O'Korn, yes) to grant Brians request as presented.

There were two county burial allowances and one base installation for approval today.
