

The regular meeting of the Huntingdon County Commissioners was held on the above date and time in the Commissioner's Meeting Room with the following present: Commissioners Sather, Walls and Thomas; Chief Clerk, Heather Fellman; Solicitor, Larry Newton; CYS Director, Kelvin Abrashoff; Chief Assessor, Missy Smith; Kathy Whelan from JVBDS; Larry and Lonnie Smith from the Pennsylvania Society of the Sons of the American Revolution; Daily News Reporter, Joe Thompson and guest, Curtis McConnaughey.

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Commissioner Sather. Prayer was led by Commissioner Thomas and the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag was led by Commissioner Walls.

It was moved by Commissioner Walls, seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (Sather, yes; Walls, yes; Thomas, yes) to approve the minutes from the previous meeting.

Kelvin Abrashoff requested consideration of approval for a purchase of service agreement with Family Services, Inc. for specialized foster care services. This is a renewal from last year for contract year July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024. It

was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Walls and carried (Thomas, yes; Sather, yes; Walls, yes).

Kelvin Abrashoff requested consideration of approval for a purchase of service agreement with Families United Network, Inc. for specialized foster care services. This is a renewal from last year for contract year July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024. It was moved by Commissioner Walls, seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (Sather, yes; Walls, yes; Thomas, yes).


There were no Matters for Action.
