The regular weekly meeting of the Huntingdon County Commissioners was held on the above date in the Commissioners Meeting Room with the following being present: Commissioners Kough Pittenger, and Fluke; Chief Clerk, Michelle Cerett; Solicitor, Peter McManamon; Josh Funk, The Daily News; Jeff Gill, Altoona Mirror; Planning Director, Richard Stahl, Grant Administrator, Maureen Safko, Recycling Coordinator, Lou Ann Shontz; CYS Director, Joyce Zolten; and visitors Charlie Coleman, Travis Cramer, Bruce Pergament, Joan and Jim Cassett.

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Chairman Kough Pittenger followed by Prayer led by Michelle Cerett and the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag led by Commissioner Kough Pittenger.

There were no additions or corrections to the August 17th minutes.

It was moved by Commissioner Fluke second by Commissioner Kough Pittenger and carried (Kough Pittenger, yes; Fluke, yes) to approve the minutes of the August 17th meeting.

It was moved by Commissioner Fluke second by Commissioner Kough Pittenger and carried (Fluke, yes; Kough Pittenger, yes;) to approve payment of invoices for the week of August 23rd.

There was one addition to the agenda that will be added prior to the action items. It is the appointment of Dan Brogdon as an At-Large member of the SAP&DC Board of Directors.

There was no public comment on the agenda today.

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First on the agenda today was Lou Ann Shontz, Recycling Coordinator. Lou Ann asked for signature on an application with DEP to contract with PSC for a household hazardous waste collection event that will be held on September 18th, 2010. The application documents the collection sites for Huntingdon, Bedford and Fulton Counties. It was moved by Commissioner Kough Pittenger, second by Commissioner Fluke and carried (Kough Pittenger, yes; Fluke, yes) to sign the DEP application for the hazardous waste collection.

Next on the agenda were Richard Stahl and Maureen Safko. They asked for a correction to be made to a tax forgiveness agreement that was signed on August 3rd. The agreement was for tax forgiveness on three Neighborhood Stabilization program properties through August 31st, 2010. It was discovered later that the tax forgiveness needed to be through December 31st. It was moved by Commissioner Fluke, second by Commissioner Kough Pittenger and carried (Fluke, yes; Kough Pittenger, yes) to amend the minutes from the August 3rd meeting and forgive the taxes on these three properties through December 31st, 2010.

The addition to the agenda was presented next. It was moved by Commissioner Fluke, second by Commissioner Kough Pittenger and carried (Kough Pittenger, yes; Fluke, yes) to appoint Dan Brogdon as an At-large member of the SAP&DC Board of Directors.

Joyce Zolten, CYS Director was next on the agenda for several items.

It was moved by Commissioner Kough Pittenger, second by Commissioner Fluke and carried (Fluke, yes; Kough Pittenger, yes) to hire Bobbi Jo Snyder to fill a vacant caseworker position at C&Y effective August 30th, 2010

It was moved by Commissioner Kough Pittenger, second by Commissioner Fluke and carried (Kough Pittenger, yes; Fluke, yes) to approve unpaid maternity leave for Amber Price effective August 20th, 2010

It was moved by Commissioner Fluke, second by Commissioner Kough Pittenger and carried (Fluke, yes; Kough Pittenger, yes) to promote Sabrina Peters from Caseworker III to Caseworker Supervisor effective August 24th, 2010.

It was moved by Commissioner Kough Pittenger, second by Commissioner Fluke and carried (Kough Pittenger, yes; Fluke, yes) to approve the promotion of Ashley Andrews from Caseworker I to Caseworker II effective August 24th, 2010

It was moved by Commissioner Fluke, second by Commissioner Kough Pittenger and carried (Fluke, yes; Kough Pittenger, yes) to approve the promotion of Kristen Mazzara from Caseworker I to Caseworker II effective August 24th, 2010

It was moved by Commissioner Kough Pittenger, second by Commissioner Fluke and carried (Kough Pittenger, yes; Fluke, yes) to approve the promotion of Lee Saylor from Caseworker I to Caseworker II effective August 24th, 2010

The Commissioners approved payment of 1 burial allowance.
