The regular weekly meeting of the Huntingdon County Commissioners was held on the above date and time in the Commissioners meeting room with the following being present: Commissioners O'Korn, Fluke and Thomas; Solicitor, Peter McManamon; Deputy Chief Clerk, Lori Sheffield; Planning Director, Mark Colussy; Grant Administrator, Marueen Safko; CYS Fiscal Supervisor, Claudia Conrad; James and Lisa Moffa, ABATE representatives; and visitors Bruce Pergament, Jim Cassatt, and Daily News Reporter, Garrison Crow.

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Commissioner O'Korn followed by Prayer led by Commissioner O'Korn and the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag led by Commissioner Thomas.

It was moved by Commissioner Fluke, seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (O'Korn, yes; Fluke, yes; Thomas, yes;) to approve the minutes of the May 7th meeting.

It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Fluke and carried (Fluke, yes; Thomas, yes; O'Korn, yes;) to approve the payment of bills for the last two week.

There was one addition to the agenda today that will be discussed at the end of the meeting.

Commissioner O'Korn reminded everyone that there will be no public meeting next Tuesday May 21st due to Election Day. It was noted that the May 28th prison board meeting has been moved to the Jail, once a year they like to hold the meetings at the facility. Commissioner O'Korn also stated it is National Law Enforcement week, he extended his gratitude for the hard work all the officers provide to the county.

There were no public comments today.

Solicitor McManamon discussed the Ordinance that will need to be adopted at a future meeting for the Mental Health and Intellectual Joinder Program. Pete stated this is something that is done every 10 years. He will advertise the ordinance and will bring to the Commissioner meeting for approval May 28th.

First on the agenda today was approval for the Proclamation of Motorcycle Safety Awareness month. Commissioner O'Korn read the Proclamation. It was moved by Commissioner Fluke, seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (Thomas, yes; O'Korn, yes; Fluke, yes;) to approve the Proclamation as presented. James and Lisa Moffa, ABATE representatives were on hand today to accept the Proclamation.

It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Fluke and carried (O'Korn, yes; Fluke, yes; Thomas, yes;) to accept the resignation of Eric Wagner, Caseworker II effective May 15th, 2013.

It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Fluke and carried (Fluke, yes; Thomas, yes; O'Korn, yes;) to approve the resignation of Keri Scott, Field Data Collector effective May 24th, 2013.

It was moved by Commissioner O'Korn, seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (Thomas, yes; O'Korn, yes; Fluke, abstain;) to appoint Commissioner Fluke as an alternate to the RC&D.

Planning Director, Mark Colussy and grant administrator, Maureen Safko were present today to present the CDBG three year community development block development plan. They have received 7 applications for this cycle of grants. This is just the preliminary plan, Maureen will advertise for 2 public meetings, then will come back to a future meeting for final approval. It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Fluke and carried (O'Korn, yes; Fluke, yes; Thomas, yes;) to accept the preliminary plan as presented.

It was moved by Commissioner Thomas seconded by Commissioner Fluke and carried (Fluke, yes; Thomas, yes; O'Korn, yes;) to approve the Purchase of Service Contracts with the Childrens Aid Society of Franklin County effective July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013.

It was moved by Commissioner Fluke, seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (Thomas, yes; O'Korn, yes; Fluke, yes;) to approve the Purchase of Service Agreement with Mid-Atlantic Youth Services Corp. of Pittston, PA., effective July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013.

There were two county veteran burial allowances and two private headstone installations approved today.

There being no further business, it was moved by Commissioner Thomas to adjourn the meeting at 10:27 a.m.
