The regular meeting of the Huntingdon County Commissioners was held on the above date and time in the Commissioner's Meeting Room with the following present: Commissioners Thomas and Reeder; Solicitor, Larry Newton; Chief Clerk, Heather Fellman; guest, Dennis Plane and Daily News Reporter, Byron Mantoan.

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Commissioner Reeder. Prayer was led by Commissioner Reeder and the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag was led by Commissioner Thomas.

It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Reeder and carried (Thomas, yes; Reeder, yes) to approve of the minutes of the August 26th and September 2nd meetings.

Under announcements, Commissioner Reeder announced the September is National Suicide Prevention and Awareness Month. Every life has value, and there is help 24/7. If you are struggling or worried about someone, call or text 988 for the suicide prevention hotlines. Veterans can press 1. Talking about mental health reduces stigma. Warning signs include talking about wanting to die, feeling hopeless, increased alcohol and drug use, and giving away belongings. If you help people over that initial thought process, you can save a life. Commissioner Reeder also announced that there will be a suicide-prevention event "Out of the Darkness Walk" Sunday, October 5th. Participants will arrive at noon and the walk will commence at 1pm. Participants from our office walk in honor of Crist Fellman, a dedicated public servant who was lost too soon.

Under new business, Lee Zeger's roof replacement recommendations were tabled at his request. It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Reeder and carried (Thomas, yes; Reeder, yes).


There were no Matters for Action.
